



It could be the best organic fertilizer for producing organic vegetables, organic fruits and ornamental plants and cost effective. Since vermicompost produces high population of beneficial microflora its application to cultivated land will also increase their population increasing soil fertility. Actinomycetes has been reported in composting, especially during late curing stage (Strom, 1985) They are very active in mineralization of organic matter and produce most of the antibiotics they help to reduce pathogenic organisms in vermicompost to some extent. Microflora analysis will let us to know the microbial diversity mainly involving in decomposition process which will be beneficial to prepare a microbial consortium culture that can be used to achieve even faster decomposition in short period of time.
